Parent's Grant and Scholarship Resolution Form

While determining your eligibility for financial aid for the 2025-26 academic year, we have discovered conflicting information.

- There was an amount reported in college grants, scholarships, or AmeriCorps benefits reported as income to the IRS.
- You would only include grant and scholarship aid **THAT WAS REPORTED TO THE IRS AS INCOME. This only includes the amount of grant & scholarships that exceeds your tuition & fees at the institution you attended.**
- Parents sometimes incorrectly assume that any grant/scholarship reported on a 1098 form should be entered. Only grant/scholarship that was issued as income, and therefore included as taxable income on the federal tax return submitted to the IRS, should be reported.
