Parent's Grant and Scholarship Resolution Form

While determining your eligibility for financial aid for the 2021-22 academic year, we have discovered conflicting information.

- There was an amount reported in FAFSA Question 91d. FAFSA Question 91d states: *Taxable college grant and scholarship aid reported to the IRS as income.*
- You would only include grant and scholarship aid **THAT WAS REPORTED TO THE IRS AS INCOME** for question 91d on the FAFSA
- Parents sometimes incorrectly assume that any grant/scholarship reported on a 1098 form should be entered for this question. Only grant/scholarship that was issued as income, and therefore included as taxable income on the federal tax return submitted to the IRS, should be reported for this question.

Review your 2019 Federal Tax Return. Was the grant/scholarship amount reported in Question 91d of your FAFSA reported as income on the tax return? Use the guide below to help you determine where income can be found on the tax return.

Please note: The corresponding lines of income as seen above on the tax return is **ONLY** from earned income as demonstrated on W2s from employers, Schedule C/C-EZ for the self-employed, and/or Schedule F for farm income or loss.

Please check one:

- Question 91d on the FAFSA should be ZERO:** The amount of Grant/Scholarship Aid was NOT reported to the IRS as income. This amount wasn't reported on any of the corresponding lines of income on your Federal Tax Return as seen in the guide above.
- Question 91d on the FAFSA should REMAIN the same.** The amount of Grant/Scholarship Aid WAS reported to the IRS as income. This amount was reported in the corresponding lines of incomes as shown in the guide above and correctly includes grants/scholarships reported as income, as well as other earned income which includes W2's, Schedule C/C-EZ, and/or Schedule F.
