Parent's Grant and Scholarship Resolution Form

While determining your eligibility for financial aid for the 2022-23 academic year, we have discovered conflicting information.

- You would only include grant and scholarship aid **THAT WAS REPORTED TO THE IRS AS INCOME** for question 91d on the FAFSA
- Parents sometimes incorrectly assume that any grant/scholarship reported on a 1098 form should be entered for this question. Only grant/scholarship that was issued as income, and therefore included as taxable income on the federal tax return submitted to the IRS, should be reported for this question.
