How does STEM designation benefit international students?

Programs designated as STEM allow international students on F-1 visas to qualify for up to three years of Optional Practical Training (OPT) after graduation. OPT is an opportunity to work in the United States within a job related to your field of study – gaining experience and connections for future opportunities. Programs without STEM designation only have one year of OPT offered.
