For students planning to transfer to UNI and major in Cybersecurity & System Administration, the following plan of study is generally recommended:

Because Southwestern CC does not offer equivalents to UNI's lower-level Cybersecurity & System Administration courses (i.e. CS 1410 and CS 1510), it is recommended that students transfer to UNI after just one year at SWiCC. While at SWiCC, students are advised to complete the following courses:

*The most important course for students to transfer with is the Intro to Computing course (CS 1510), as this course is a prerequisite to many other courses in the program.
