Semester two: take MAT 114 Math for Elementary Educators Math I as the math course and ENG 105 Composition I as the Communications course.

Semester three: take PHI 101 Introduction to Philosophy or PHI 105 Introduction to Ethics as the Social and Behavioral Sciences/Humanities course, and take ECE 290 Early Childhood Program Admin with SPC 101 Fundamentals of Oral Communication as the two courses from option two. Additionally, take ENG 106 Composition II as the AAS Core Distributed credits.

Semester four: take LIT 105 Children's Literature, PSY 281 Educational Psychology, and EDU 245 Exceptional Learner as the three courses from option two. Additionally, take either BIO 104 Introductory Biology w/lab or PHS 152 Astronomy as the AAS Core Distributed credits.

SCIENCE REQUIREMENTS:

To be recommended for an lowa teaching license, students must complete a minimum of 9 credit hours in the sciences. These credits must come from three different areas:

- Life Science: An Inquiry to Life Science course, or an Introductory or General Biology course
- Physical Science: An Inquiry to Physical Science course, or an Introductory or General Chemistry or Physics course
- Earth/Space Science: An Inquiry to Earth and Space Science course, or an Introductory Astronomy, Weather, or Earth Science course

Note: Environmental Science will not fulfill any of the three.

- □ Complete at least 10 hours of PK-12 classroom observation (TEACHING 2020 or equivalent)
- □ Apply to the Teacher Education Program
