For students planning to transfer to UNI and major in Business (e.g. Accounting, Business Teaching, Management, MIS, Marketing, Finance, Economics, Real Estate, Supply Chain), the following plan of study is generally recommended:

1. Complete an Associate of Arts (A.A.) at Southeastern Iowa Community College
2. Complete ALL of the following courses at SCC (as electives within the A.A. degree)

ADMISSION TO COLLEGE OF BUSINESS REQUIREMENTS

1. Completion of the ALEKS Math Placement Examination
2. 30 cumulative semester hours of college credit
3. C- or better in ECON 1041 - Principles of Macroeconomics
4. C- or better in the following:
 - a. ECON 1021 – Decision Analytics (pre-req STAT 1772 or equivalent) OR
 - b. ECON 1011 – Stats for Business Analytics (pre-req of STAT 1772 or equivalent)
5. C- or better in an approved English composition course, such as ENGLISH 1005 - College Writing and Research (this would be the equivalent of Composition I & II at a community college)
6. Total or UNI cumulative GPA of at least 2.50 on all university-level courses
7. Declaration form filled with the UNI Business Advising Office (which you will do at Transfer Orientation)

NOTES FROM AN ADVISOR

1. All students must complete the ALEKS Math Placement Examination, regardless if you took it at your community college
2. Students must complete both an introductory stats course AND a business stats course
